

Welcome to Shadow Journey Tarot. This 78card deck includes original art by artist J Edward Neill and card concepts & keywords by Heather Neill. This is our second tarot deck, and our most serious divination tool yet.

Shadow Journey Tarot is intended to be a powerful tool of self-reflection and growth. We hope you will use it as a personal tool of spiritual evolution, learning more about yourself with each card pulled. More than anything, we hope you enjoy your experience.

Shadow Journey Tarot illustrates the travels of a young girl through the various stages of her life. The Fool (pictured as a girl or woman) begins as a young, fresh novice, ready for adventure. On her way, she'll encounter friends and foes, challenges and triumphs. Her allies and adversaries include Skelly (from J Edward's Skelly & the Girl painting series) haunting cloaked figures, and a handful of animal companions. The setting of her journey is surreal in nature, including realms and landscapes not quite of this world.

Artistically, the deck contains art spanning nearly seven years of work. The very first artwork completed (Seven of Goblets) was finished in 2016, while the final piece (Six of Cloaks) was completed in May of 2023. Each and every card originates from an original acrylic painting, mostly on sturdy wood panels, a few on cotton canvasses.

There are many ways to read this tarot deck, which is true of all decks. No one method is considered the absolute best. Rather than include separate reversal definitions, we believe it's up to the querent to determine the meaning of each card by careful consideration of its placement in a spread. We encourage querents to discover what works best for them, and to experiment with multiple styles. For a wide swath of tarot-reading ideas and a variety of layouts and spreads, we recommend consulting the internet, which contains a treasure trove of tarot methodology.


For reference, Shadow Journey Tarot suits translate to traditional tarot suits as follows:

Candles = Wands Goblets = Cups Cloaks = Swords Bones = Pentacles

# Major Arcana

The cards of the Major Arcana tell the story of the Fool's Journey, represented in this deck as a girl or woman. The Fool is card 0 in the Major Arcana. The next twenty cards represent different phases of personal development, individuation, spiritual growth, and universal human experiences. The final card, The World, represents the completion of the cycle.



### 0 The Fool

### Realm of Possibilities

The Fool stands in the realm of possibilities, balancing on the bones of her previous journey, which have recently come to an end. She travels light, carrying only a basket of flowers representing the hope and optimism needed to begin her next journey. Here, she is in the space where endings and beginnings overlap, a place of potentiality where ideas thrive.

To be The Fool is to be present in the energy of infinite possibilities, without any barriers or limits weighing on her mind. She is not laden with expectations; she prepares for her new journey with an open heart. The Fool represents spontaneity, originality, and innocence. She is daring and open to finding happiness in unexpected places.

The Fool is naïve and unequipped for troubles that lie ahead. Throwing caution aside, she may forget to look before she leaps into the unknown.

The Fool's challenge is to remain courageous and optimistic while taking the time to prepare for unforeseen obstacles she may encounter along the way.



# 1 The Magician

### Magic of Manifestation

Standing outside the realm of possibility is The Magician. The Magician is skillful, quick to act, and an expert at manifesting whatever he imagines. The Magician possesses all the elemental tools of the Tarot (fire, water, air, and earth), making him a master of his passions, heart, and mind.

The Magician encourages you to connect to your innate ability to create your destiny. He reminds us that we all have the tools to manifest what we truly want in our lives if we are willing to dream without limits and work hard, even when it's difficult or unpleasant.

The Magician can be skilled in deception or trickery. Do not allow anyone to manipulate the appearance of a situation in your life or pull the strings behind the scenes. Do not deceive yourself or use your talents to deceive others.

The Magician may signify that your talents lie dormant and are not being used to their fullest potential. To manifest, you must realize your own potential and dream fearlessly.



# 2 The High Priestess

# Connecting to Intuition

The High Priestess stands beneath a dark moon that represents worldly knowledge, but her attention is on the white moon hovering above her hand. The purity of her intuition is reflected in this moon, for she has complete confidence in the power of her inner voice and doesn't need to look elsewhere to seek validation. She possesses insight into the mysteries hidden within herself, in the world around her, and in the subconscious realm.

In this knowledge she finds equilibrium and a deep sense of peace. The High Priestess assures you that you have access to these mysteries through your own intuition and connection to divine wisdom. Allow your inner voice to guide you to the truth.

The High Priestess may make an appearance when you are purposely ignoring your inner voice because you don't want to see the truth of a situation. Fearlessly embrace the enlightenment she brings you. Use it to accurately see the intentions of others and know who has your best interest at heart.



# 3 The Empress

### Power of Creation

A symbol of creation, The Empress stands in a field surrounded by vibrant blossoms. She is attentive to them, sharing her nurturing energy with each flower, and in return they thrive in her presence. The Empress encourages you to connect to the creator and nurturer that lives within you. Now is a time of creative abundance and self-expression.

Your genuine and very personal creative energy flows through you. There are many ways in which you can harness it and bring it to life in the world around you. You may prefer to embark on a solo creative project, or you may choose to co-create with others, combining your unique energies into one project.

You may find yourself with the powerful urge to be a nurturer. This can be expressed in different ways, such as caring for people, animals, plants or land, or by paying more attention to your own needs and nurturing yourself.

The appearance of The Empress may indicate you are experiencing a creative block. Connecting to the earth by spending time in nature, grounding yourself by walking barefoot on natural surfaces, sitting in a forest or natural area, or meditating near moving water are all things you can do to re-connect to your creativity.



# 4 The Emperor

# Stability and Order

The Emperor is the companion energy to The Empress. Instead of a field of flowers, he stands in a field of bones, symbolizing the lengths he will go to in order to defend who and what he loves. What The Empress creates and nurtures, The Emperor protects. He is a powerful leader and authority figure who is fair and just. The sturdy structure behind him represents the stability and order his energy brings into the world.

The Emperor may appear when you are being called to a leadership position that requires you to possess traits similar to his. Strive to be powerful, protective, and firm, but also fair. Share your knowledge and expertise with those you lead.

Drawing The Emperor may also mean you need to be strategic in the way you approach something in your life right now. If you are pursuing a goal, be sure to do so in a well-ordered manner, staying methodical and focused.

Sometimes leadership and authority can go to a person's head. The Emperor warns against misusing your position of power or mistreating those you are meant to lead. Be aware of anyone around you who may be abusing a position of authority.



# 5 The Hierophant

## Keeper of Knowledge

The Hierophant symbolizes tradition, convention, and institutions. He is the keeper of knowledge, and he passes down his wisdom to earnest pupils. His beliefs are etched in stone, built on a foundation of core values that have been passed down through the years.

The Hierophant may stand for commitment. This could be commitment to a belief system, an institution, even to another person through marriage. You may find yourself seeking a conventional foundation for your life right now and choose to find others in your community who share your values.

The Hierophant also appears when you have been spending a lot of time learning through deep study and information-gathering. You may have recently started questioning, even challenging, what you have learned or been taught by others.

Here, The Hierophant represents the solid structure of tradition. However, a white moon appears in place of his head. It is the same moon that hovers above the palm of The High Priestess, symbolizing enlightenment through the power of your own intuition. This image suggests it may be time to expand your mind and start building your own belief systems.



### 6 The Lovers

### Union

The core meaning of The Lovers card is union. It may be the balance and harmony you feel within yourself when you are able to live in a way that is true to you. It signifies the union of knowledge, values, and beliefs. It may represent someone you know (or will know) with whom you share a strong connection. It could also indicate the need to make a choice.

Moving into the energy of The Lovers, you can release the standardized knowledge and beliefs of The Hierophant and develop your own personal beliefs. This will change your perception of the world around you and allow you to live authentically. You may decide to merge parts of the old with the new, creating a union of knowledge within you.

The Lovers card may appear when you have someone in your life with whom you feel a magnetic attraction. This indicates a beautiful relationship where each person openly trusts and respects the other. It is a bond you must continue to nurture.

You may find that The Lovers card appears when you are faced with making a choice. You may find it difficult to choose, desiring to merge each option into one easy answer rather than choose one thing (or person) over the other. Unfortunately, you must

decide. Be sure to make the decision that feels right to you.

Sometimes you may pull The Lovers when you are in external conflict, likely with someone close to you. You may feel disconnected from this important person in your life. There may be an imbalance between you, disrupting your once peaceful union. You will have to decide whether your relationship can be repaired or if it is time to part ways.



### 7 The Chariot

### **Focused Action**

You have come to the fast-moving energy of The Chariot, and you are ready to harness it. You have your heart set on something, and you feel the fire of determination pushing you to move forward and claim what you want. The Chariot sits, unmoving, and waits to be your mode of transportation. Before you can take the reins, you must devise a detailed plan of action.

At this stage in your journey, you have a strong sense of who you are and what you want. You must also be realistic and have an idea of how you will attain these things. If you remain determined and stay the course, you will overcome the challenges ahead. Be bold. There is no room for indecision or trepidation now. Victory will be yours if you are assertive.

If you question whether you should move forward with a dream or goal, The Chariot is confirmation that you are headed in the right direction.

Sometimes The Chariot can appear as a warning that you lack focus and direction in your life. What is it you really want? If you lack ambition or confidence, know that you have what it takes to be triumphant in your pursuits.



# 8 Strength

### Personal Power

The Strength card represents inner strength and carries the energy of personal power. It is a reminder of your ability to show compassion in times of struggle, exude control in times of chaos, and display courage in times of adversity. You have the gift of resilience. You can overcome any obstacle in life.

If you are currently facing a challenging situation in your life, the Strength card warns you to watch your emotions. Strong, reactive emotions or retaliation will only make a situation more difficult. Be sure to keep your composure.

You may feel vulnerable, low-energy, or on the verge of defeat right now. Perhaps you have experienced setback after setback and find it hard to muster the strength to continue fighting. Maybe you feel the weight of the world on your shoulders. You may find it harder and harder to control your emotions and sense you are losing control of yourself. The Strength card can appear when you need to withdraw for a while and then continue the battle after you have regained your strength.



### 9 The Hermit


### Reflection and Refinement

The Hermit knows when she needs to withdraw from the world and spend time alone reflecting on her life. She uses this time to examine her relationships, her career, and his day-to-day activities. She recognizes what gives her strength, what depletes her, what must change, and what should stay the same.

You may draw The Hermit card when you are at an important crossroads in your life. You likely need to make a life-changing decision that takes a lot of thought. Take enough time to meditate so you can reach the best decision for your personal happiness.

The Hermit may represent a mentor, teacher, or spiritual guide who will come into your life at a time when you need them most.

Introspection can be valuable, but too much can have negative effects on relationships. Sometimes The Hermit warns that you have spent too much time in isolation and have become detached from people important to you.



### 10 Wheel of Fortune

### Cycles

The Wheel of Fortune symbolizes the cycles we experience throughout our lives. Fortune and misfortune, good and bad times, beginnings and endings—life is filled with ups and downs. These cycles are inevitable. Most of the time, we can't change them. What we experience a time of misfortune, unexpected endings, or challenges, we can try to find comfort in knowing that things will get better.

The Wheel of Fortune may appear in a reading when you receive signs from the universe. You may have noticed a lot of synchronicities and repeating number patterns lately. If you are at a pivotal point in your life, these could be answers to questions you have about what to do next.

You may draw the Wheel of Fortune when your luck is about to change. If you have been experiencing a time of good fortune, there may be down times and struggles ahead. If you've been down on your luck or facing challenges, things may change for the better.



# 11 Justice

# Truth and Accountability

Justice carries the energy of actions and consequences. If you have done something to wrong someone in the past, you will now be held accountable for your actions. If you are currently harming someone else or being untruthful, you will be called out and forced to accept the consequences. Change the situation now before it gets worse.

The Justice card may appear when the truth is being withheld or a secret is being kept. It can indicate that someone is lying to you or causing trouble, and you are not yet aware of the damage being done. With the Justice card, truth will be revealed.

Sometimes you may draw Justice when you are withholding the truth from yourself. You may deny that you have done something because you don't want to feel wrong or guilty. If so, you must accept the truth and face the consequences.



# 12 The Hanged Man

# Suspension


Sometimes in life we need to hit the pause button and look at things from a different perspective. The Hanged Man carries the energy of suspension and appears when we need to bring everything in our lives to a halt, putting the brakes on our actions, thoughts, and even relationships.

If your days begin to look the same, if you are trapped in the monotony of routine, The Hanged Man appears to tell you it's time to make changes. Step out of the flow of your routine and look at your life from a different perspective. Look for hidden opportunities you may have missed, new possibilities for yourself, and ways to change your routine. Remember, The Hanged Man is not a card of action but a card indicating a waiting period. While it is important to reflect on what you can do to improve your life, it may not be time to make sweeping changes. In quiet contemplation, The Hanged Man stays suspended as long as it takes to hear his heart's desires.

The appearance of The Hanged Man may indicate a struggling relationship that needs to be suspended. If you have been in conflict with someone close to you, it may take a period of separation to allow the air to clear between you. During this time, consider any negative

patterns in the relationship and what can be done to break them.

If you have already been in a period of suspension or indecision, you may draw The Hanged Man when it is time to be decisive and put your life back into motion.



### 13 Death

### **Transition**

The Death card represents not literal death but the energy of transition. The Death part of this transition allows necessary change to occur so something new can begin. The transformation can be external, internal, or both. It is the period of action following The Hanged Man's time of suspension.

Drawing the Death card can be disconcerting but it is one of the most positive cards in the Tarot if looked at from a different perspective. Yes, you will need to be brave and to let go of something familiar, even comfortable, to allow change to take place and that can be scary. Releasing the old will make way for new opportunities that you may not have believed possible.

Sometimes Death may bring in the energy of transformation when an internal change is needed. You may not realize that old mindsets, limiting beliefs, bad habits, and behavior patterns may be holding you back and keeping you from being happy.

You may draw the Death card when you are resisting change that is already occurring in your life. You may cling to unhealthy attachments to people, a certain lifestyle, or a "safe" and easy way of living. Death warns you to release these attachments because they only hold you back.



# 14 Temperance

#### Self-Control

Temperance brings an energy of peace and balance.

This energy surrounds those who have mastered the ability to maintain self-control, even in the most trying times. Anyone can tap into the energy of Temperance, but it takes a notable amount of self-discipline.

Temperance can indicate that you have mastered this art and that others around you may have benefited from your go-with-the-flow approach to life.

Temperance may indicate you need to get your life back into balance. If you feel stressed or overwhelmed, harness the energy of Temperance to restore calm to your life.

Temperance may appear in a spread when you have overindulged in something, to the point where it may use up a lot of time and mental energy. It could be food, drink, sex, or excessive purchasing. Temperance reminds you to do everything in moderation.

If you have been feeling impatient, angry, or have been struggling with extreme emotions, Temperance urges you to exercise patience with yourself and others. You can't control everything around you, but you can control your reactions. Pay close attention to how you interact with others.



### 15 The Devil

# **Bondage**

The Devil card represents deceit, bondage, and the illusion that you don't have any control over negative influences in your life. You may be a slave to your own thoughts, thinking you need to live a life of overindulgence. The opposite energy of Temperance, The Devil appears when you wish to do nothing in moderation, constantly finding yourself giving in to instant gratification or excess.

The Devil card also carries the energy of illumination. It may appear when you need to truly see what keeps you feeling powerless. Acknowledge that these things have a hold on you. You are the master of your thoughts and emotions. You have the power to tackle your dependencies, negative thoughts, behavioral patterns, addictions, and anything else you may face.

The Devil may indicate you have already acknowledged that a change needs to be made and you are now ready to free yourself from constraints.

Demolish all limiting beliefs, destroy all fears, and focus on freeing yourself from entrapment.



## 16 The Tower

# Upheaval

At first glance, The Tower appears to be an impressive structure, sturdy and colossal. In reality, the foundation is weak, and the structure is built on unstable ground.

Its fall is inevitable. When it goes down, it will be quick.

The Tower card signifies upheaval in your life. Brace yourself. Prepare for the unexpected. You cannot predict what your life will look like after the dust clears.

The Tower may appear when you are about to be ripped from your comfort zone, physically or emotionally. You may like the way your life is going now and wish for things to stay the same, but underneath the surface, something isn't quite right. There may be secrets, illusions, or corruption beneath everything you've built. Now it will be revealed.

Resisting will only make it more difficult. Remember, these changes will benefit you. You can rebuild something new and true to you on a much stronger foundation.



### 17 The Star

### Hope

As you move forward in your journey, leaving the rubble of the fallen Tower behind you, The Star appears and welcomes you into a new energy of hope. If you feel exhausted, lost, even hopeless, allow the healing energy of The Star to embrace you.

After what you have been through, you may not feel like rejoicing at the possibilities of a new beginning. For now, just know the energy of renewal is available to you. See The Star as a beacon of hope shining above, ready to guide you along a new path.

The Star is a symbol of inner strength. If you feel alone, know that the universe is ready to co-create with you. You have a storehouse of knowledge and experience within you, a resilience that you probably haven't tapped into yet. When you are ready, use these tools to rebuild your life into something beautiful and fulfilling.

You may draw The Star when you feel you've lost all faith and motivation to move on. You may be despondent after your recent experiences. Your spirit may feel drained of hope. See The Star as a symbol of faith that things can only get better from here if you keep persevering.



### 18 The Moon

#### Illusion

Like The Devil, The Moon appears when you experience the feeling of being controlled by something in your life. However, while The Devil signifies knowable urges and external influences, The Moon's energy is more nebulous, closely linked to the subconscious, shadowy areas of the mind.

The Moon seeks to illuminate fears, anxieties, illusions, and hidden truths. Your actions may be driven by these mental deceivers that exist for self-preservation and self-protection. They've likely been with you for many years. They've had a strong impact on how you perceive yourself and the world around you. The Moon encourages you to explore these shadows in your mind and become aware of how they influence your daily life.

Sometimes The Moon will appear when the appearance of a great relationship or situation in your life is really an illusion. It may appear to be great on the surface, but something about it triggers your intuition and raised warning flags. Pay attention to these signs. Examine things closely to find the truth.



## 19 The Sun

### Pure Joy

Always a welcome sign in a Tarot reading, The Sun radiates positive energy. You have reached a period of optimism, joy, and positivity. Things can't get any better than this. Enjoy this time in your life and savor every moment.

This is a time for you to shine in many ways. You may feel you are experiencing a rebirth or renewal of your spirit. You may even feel you've reconnected to your inner child. Allow yourself to emanate pure joy and attract positivity. The Sun brings abundance into your life, possibly even new relationships.

The Sun indicates that now is a good time to be creative. The childlike happiness you are experiencing is the perfect energy for self-expression. There isn't any room for doubt or feelings of self-consciousness here. Allow yourself to create without inhibitions.

You may draw The Sun when you enter a period of success. You feel vibrant and unstoppable. You may even be ready to make life-changing decisions. Now is a great time to make dreams come true.



# 20 Judgement

### Self-Evaluation

The penultimate step in your journey through the major arcana, Judgement asks you to stop and self-evaluate. In a sense, Judgement is a gatekeeper for The World. You must pause here and consider your journey thus far.

If you look at your life as a puzzle, this is a time when you need to make sure you have all the pieces, and that they are in the proper place. The picture your puzzle creates is built by your experiences, actions, and consequences. It also reflects your trials, triumphs, and moments of self-reflection.

Have you released what you should and left it in the past? Have you let go of limiting beliefs about yourself and your life? Do you have an accurate and honest sense of yourself? Do you know what it is you truly want for yourself? Take the time to reflect on these questions before you go any further.

Depending on how you answer these questions, you may need to make difficult decisions. Cast aside all doubts and fears. Set everything right so you can move towards completion.



### 21 The World

# Accomplishment

The World represents the full circle of your journey from beginning to end. You have completed a cycle. It's time for you to celebrate this moment. As you have more cycles to complete throughout your life, a new journey awaits you. For now, enjoy what you have accomplished.

Whatever your personal accomplishment looks like, take a moment to reflect on how you made it here. Celebrate your personal growth and all your successes along the way. Remember the lessons you learned throughout this journey. Take them with you on the next one.

If you haven't quite made it to the end, be sure to tie up any loose ends. You may still lack understanding in a particular area and need to spend more time in reflection before you can cross the finish line. Find the weak spots. Release anything that holds you back.

# Minor Arcana

The Minor Arcana represents everyday themes and aspects of daily life. It consists of four suits. Here, in Shadow Journey Tarot, the four suits are: Candles, Goblets, Cloaks, and Bones, which are used in place of the traditional Tarot suits: Wands, Cups, Swords, and Pentacles.

There are four court cards in each suit: Page, Knight, Queen, and King. These four cards can represent your different personality traits and behavioral patterns or the different stages of your life. They may also represent actual people who are in your life now, have been in your life in the past, or will be in your life in the future.

# **Candles**

The suit of Candles represents ideas, inspiration, ambition, and creativity. It corresponds to the swift element of fire. The energy of Candles is fast moving, action-oriented, and passionate.



### Ace of Candles

# The Spark

The Ace of Candles is a spark of inspiration. When it appears, it brings the energy of something new or reignites an old passion buried inside you. This card encourages you to take a leap: follow your heart, listen to your gut, hear your inner voice. Embrace the fiery energy it brings. Pour it into what you truly want, whether it be personal or spiritual growth, romance, a new project, or a career change. Allow passion to bring you to life spiritually and energetically.

The challenge with the Ace of Candles is to know where to direct this new energy. You must have a clear idea where to start. What path must you take to get what you want? Create a plan but move quickly - do not let the fire die out. If you are indecisive, confused, prone to procrastination, or unwilling to put things into motion, you will miss this opportunity.



### Two of Candles

### The Plan

Whereas the Ace of Candles brings in the energy of inspiration, the Two of Candles tells you it is time to craft a plan of progression. Protect your spark and keep it alive while you take the time to carefully plan the necessary steps to reach your goal. You may feel tempted to move ahead without a fully realized plan. Keep in mind that the planning stage is important. It will allow you to move ahead with focus and intention.

The challenge with the Two of Candles is being able to keep your focus on the bigger picture during the preparation phase, while also maintaining your initial enthusiasm and excitement. It is important to hold on to your passion while you take the time to focus on the practical aspects of your new ambition.



## Three of Candles

## Expansion

The Three of Candles expands horizons. This is not a time to pause or wait for things to come to you. It is a time for movement and growth. Fan the flame of inspiration by exploring options and choices, creating opportunities for new discoveries, and finding new, interesting ways to tackle any challenges. Now is the time to engage in activities that will allow you to experience new things and expand your mind.

Traveling, taking a class, making a point to meet new people are all ways to promote personal growth.

The Three of Candles wants you to avoid limiting yourself by playing it safe or sticking with what you already know. The challenge is the fear of the unknown. It is time to step away from your comfort zone and venture into new territories.



## Four of Candles

### The Foundation

Through planning, breaking out of your comfort zone, hard work, and successful manifesting, you have created a solid foundation for yourself and reached an important milestone. It is time to celebrate! The energy of the Four of Candles is stable, balanced, and joyful. Take time to step back and enjoy what you have achieved in your life. This card can be a doorway to your heart's desire – whatever that is for you personally. The Four of Candles is also a card of comfort and familiarity. Now is a wonderful time to gather with friends, loved ones, or return to the place that feels like home to you.

If you are feeling unsupported or in conflict with those closest to you, the Four of Candles arrives with the challenge of taking the time to celebrate your accomplishments on your own. If reconciliation with your support system is not an option, find ways to acknowledge and support yourself, honoring your achievements in a way that is special to you.



## Five of Candles

# Rivalry

Others have noticed your progress and not everyone is thrilled to see you doing so well for yourself. The Five of Candles brings the energy of conflict, rivalry, competition – even jealousy. You may have already detected tension between you and another or it may still brew quietly beneath the surface. Depending on how you react to this conflict, this challenging time could lead to opportunities for growth.

The Five of Candles brings the challenge of knowing when it is best to remain silent and let things pass, and when it is best to confront the conflict and find an effective way to communicate to resolve any issues between you and others.



## Six of Candles

# Victory

Congratulations! You passed through the difficult energy of the Five of Candles while staying focused on your goal. The Six of Candles announces your victory.

Others are recognizing your hard work and achievements. You may even receive an award. Take pride in your accomplishments and celebrate this triumphant moment in your life.

At times, it may be hard for any of us to believe we have come so far in our lives. The challenge with the

Six of Candles is to accept that YOU have accomplished remarkable things. Do not second guess your abilities or allow self-doubt to creep in. Stay in the focused, fiery energy of candles and continue to move forward towards your next goal.



### Seven of Candles

### **Defend and Protect**

The recognition brought in with the Six of Candles was not all positive. Now that others have witnessed your success, there are those who wish to take it away from you. 


## Ten of Candles

## Family Contentment


The personal success of the Nine of Goblets has evolved into the contentment of the Ten of Goblets.


### Six of Bones


### Seven of Bones
